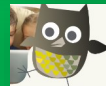


PEWITHALL WEEKLY NEWSLETTER— 2nd May 2025

Please make sure your child's PE kit is in school every day.

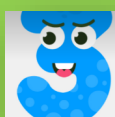
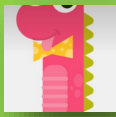
Lost Property
