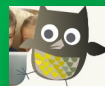


PEWITHALL WEEKLY NEWSLETTER— 9th May 2025

Thank you for your continued support with parking around Kenilworth Avenue and helping to keep our children safe.



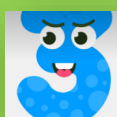
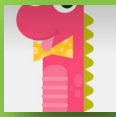

Please make sure your child's PE kit is in school every day. Thank you for your support.

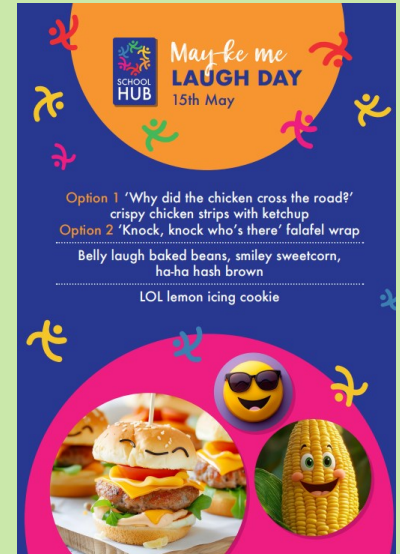
Snack and Lunches
